In April 1994, genocide broke out in Rwanda. Over the course of 100 days, an estimated 800,000 people were brutally killed by their neighbors. Today, Rwanda represents a model post-conflict society with one of the fastest growing economies in Africa. This intimate three week experience offers a unique behind-the-scenes look at the factors that led to Rwanda's genocide and its remarkable efforts at reconciliation and recovery.
